1. Approval of Minutes from the May 18th BCRC Board Meeting. *Commission Member Dick made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, Commission Member Ward made a second and the agenda passed 5-0.*

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Approval of Financial Statements from May 2022 Commission Member Ganoung made a motion to pass the Financial Statements from April 2022, Commission Member Dick made a 2nd, it passed 5-0.
- 2. Health Insurance Quotes
 - Director McClure share with the board health insurance quotes obtained from the two companies that provided quotes, Blue Cross and Blue Shield and United Health Care. The BCBS quote came in at \$6360.14 per month. United Health Care came in at 7,738.51 per month. VSP is unchanged from the previous year at \$143.94. The board accepted the BCBS proposal and voted to pick up the employee premiums for the 2022-2023 cycle. Commission Member Ward made a motion and was seconded by Commission Member Ward, motion carries 5-0.
- 3. RNR Hearing Notification

 Director McClure presented mill levy information to the board. The RNR rate for BCRC for the 2022-2023 budget cycle is 3.391. The board voted to exceed the RNR rate.

5. August Meeting

Per the state timeline, budget and RNR hearings need to be held between August 20th and September 20th. The board opted to keep the August meeting on August 17th and bump the September meeting up a week to September 14th to camply with the timeline. The BCRC opted to hold the September board meeting, budget hearing and RNR hearing on Wednesday, September 14th.

6. City Appointed Board Position
Ginny Honomichl's city appointed term on the board expires in July 2022. Ms. Honomichl has interest in renewing her term. The board voted unanimously to forward Ginny's name to the city for reinstatement.

- 1. USD Strategic Plan Committee

 Director McClure shared with the board that the school district has hired the
 architecture firm DLR to help facilitate the facilities portion of the strategic plan. DLR
 will provide some parameters in forming a committee for this project. More
 communication to come from the school district on the timeline for upcoming meetings.
- 2. Web Site / Registration Update

 Director McClure shared the latest in the transition of updating of the website and registration software to CivicRec. McClure hopes to have a website prototype at the July meeting.

- The Baseball/Softball/T-Ball/Little Sluggers season started out with 5 days of rainouts; rescheduling has been challenging with a full schedule already. Weather permitting, the last day for baseball/softball is Monday, July 11th.

We currently have 8 teams on different dates who will get introduced on the field, run out to the positions with the Blues players, sit in the dugout with the team and play catch with the right fielder between innings.
- The Baldwin City Blues will also host a FREE clinic for our BCRC summer ball kids. It will be held on Saturday, June 25th at 2:00pm. They will provide T-shirts to the first 50 participants and a meal for all kids who participate.
- The concession stand will remain open throughout the Blues season and is running smoothly with vendors, Pepsi and Sysco.
- The June/July cornhole league will conclude on July 11th. 16 teams have registered for this session.
