

BCRC T-Ball- 3&4 Year Olds

Playing Rules

- The purpose of T-Ball is to teach the FUNdamentals of the game of baseball. Children should be encouraged to do their best and be applauded for their effort.
- Score will not be kept.
- All members of the team shall bat and play in the field. A team's at-bat is complete when all members of the team have batted once.
- The entire lineup will bat, no matter how many outs are made. The last batter will run around the bases until he/she scores.
- Switch defensive positions every inning.
 - You can use a catcher if you want.
- Return the ball to umpire after each play.
- Let the umpire know when the last batter is coming up to bat.
- Each game shall consist of 3 innings or 45 minutes; whichever comes first.
- The team listed last on the schedule will be the home team.
 - (Example: Team 1 vs. Team 2 – Team 2 is home)
- Helmets will not be given out and are not required. They may be used if they'd like.
- Please have team ready to take field at the scheduled start time.
- Games will be played at the Baldwin City Sports Complex on Field #3 and practices will be at the fields north of the High School.
