

BCRC T-Ball- 3&4 Year Olds

Playing Rules

- The purpose of T-Ball is to teach the FUNdamentals of the game of baseball. Children should be encouraged to do their best and be applauded for their effort.
- Score will not be kept.
- All members of the team shall bat and play in the field. A team's at-bat is complete when all members of the team have batted once.
- The entire lineup will bat, not matter how many outs are made.
- Switch defensive positions every inning.
 - You can use a catcher if you want.
- Return the ball to umpire after each play.
- Let the umpire know when the last batter is coming up to bat.
- Each game shall consist of 3 innings or 45 minutes; whichever comes first.
- The team listed last on the schedule will be the home team.
 - (Example: Team 1 vs. Team 2 – Team 2 is home)
- All batters shall wear a helmet.
- Please have team ready to take field at the scheduled start time. There are not any lights at our fields, so daylight will eventually run out.
- Games and practices will be at the fields north of the High School.

Equipment

- All equipment will be kept in the JoBox at the High School fields. Each coach will be given a key and will use the equipment for practices and games. Each bag has the same amount of balls, bats and helmets. Please respect the rest of the teams in the league and put the equipment back the way it was left for you.
