





HATHA CHAIR YOGA:

Traditional yoga instruction for both new and continuing students. This class consists of powerful, flowing postures that promote healthy circulation, body awareness and well-being. The focus is on breath, flexibility, balance, core strength, lengthening of muscles and building bone density. Modifications are provided to fit the individual needs of each student.
